T.C. Barnesley Foundation Scholarship

History of Foundation:

The T. C. Barnesley Foundation was established in 1977. It was created by Mr. Tom Barnesley in his will. Mr. Barnesley was a rancher and resident of Crane County. He very strongly believed in the importance of furthering the education of youth in Agriculture. Throughout the years, many graduates of Crane High School have benefited from his gift. 4H clubs of Crane, Ward, and Upton Counties and the Sandhills Stock Show have also received donations from this foundation.

Eligibility Requirements:

The following requirements must be met to be considered for a scholarship:

1. Applicant must be a graduate (or will be in spring semester) of Crane High School.
2. Applicant must be enrolled in or accepted to an accredited university.
3. Applicant must be in good standings with the university. The Advisory Committee expects candidates to maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0.
4. Applicant must carry a minimum of 12 hours each semester.
5. Applicant must pursue a degree in Animal Husbandry, Veterinary Medicine, Soil Conservation or similar fields directly related to ranching and farming.

Application Deadlines:

- Graduating High School Seniors:
 - No later than March 1 of year to graduate.
- Students already in College:
 - No later than July 1 of year before fall semester.

College Students: An official transcript from the university with grades of last semester completed and accumulative GPA.
